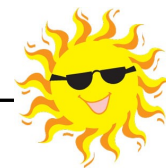

Our new school year officially starts on Monday, Sept. 10. Prior to that date, all families will be filling out updated Fee Contracts, as we do every year.

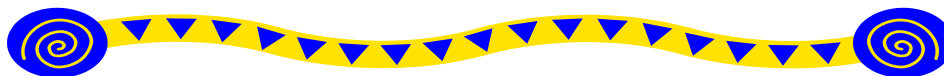
Beginning on Sept. 3, you are required to be charged for every day listed on your child's Fee Contract. Billing statements will be based on the Fee Contracts. **Even if your child does not attend on a scheduled day, you will be charged for that day.**

Also, we need to know at least one week in advance if you want to bring your child(ren) on a previously unscheduled day. **Please do not drop off your child if you have not made arrangements in advance.** It will be your responsibility to fill in earned vacation days ahead of a planned

absence. If you do not have earned vacation days, you will be charged for a scheduled day even if your child is sick on that day.

Don't forget, during the school year, we offer many educational extras not found at many other centers such as instruction in Italian, French and German languages; in addition a librarian is on staff for our library program; and a challenging curriculum in language arts, math, and sciences.

Important Sunscreen Reminder

We can apply sunscreen to your child **only** if you provide it and fill out a permission slip.

Also, you must put on the first application of sunscreen before drop-off. Teachers do not apply sunscreen in the morning or at lunch recess.

Teachers reapply sunscreen in the afternoon, if we are going outside.

Water Bottle Policy

If you aren't familiar, here is how it works. Send in a water cup or bottle every day with your child's name on it. We will make it available for them to take outside during playtime and send it back every night (unless it's a disposable bottle).

Please make sure to refill it with clean water every night and send it back the following day.

Monthly Menu and Snack Policy

Each month we publish a new menu listing each days' snacks and lunches. Please make sure you are checking the menu regularly, **especially if your child has any food allergies or sensitivities.**

For example, if your child cannot drink milk, be aware that we often serve dairy items at snack — such as cheese, yogurt, cottage cheese, and ice cream. On days when the snack is something that your child cannot eat, **please provide an alternate snack.**

However, if the snack is something that your child doesn't enjoy eating, our policy is we will serve that item to your child in the hopes that he or she will be encouraged to try new things. Do not send in alternate snacks unless your child is actually allergic or sensitive to a certain food.
