We all know how fast our children can grow. Please check your child(ren)'s cubbies and make sure they contain clothes that fit.


Children should have a full change of clothes plus socks and shoes. Extra underwear too!






GIRL SCOUT COOKIES ON SALE IN THE OFFICE
