Welcome to the start of the 2022 school year at Great Lakes Child Development Center. We are so excited for the start of the new school year. This year will be filled with educational fun and leaning!

The first official day of the school year is Monday, Sept. 12th. **Pre-K and Preschool students begin their day at 9 a.m.** A welcome letter, schedule, and supply list will be sent home soon.



Our new school year officially starts on Monday, Sept. 12. Prior to that date, all families will be filling out updated Fee Contracts, as we do every year. **Effective September 12, 2022, GLCDC will increase** the weekly tuition prices to \$2.00 a day. Please see the attached price list.

Beginning on Sept. 6, you are required to be charged for every day listed on your child's Fee Contract. Billing statements will be based on the Fee Contracts. Even if your child does not attend on a scheduled day, you will be charged for that day.

Also, we need to know at least one week in advance if you want to bring your child(ren) on a previously unscheduled day. **Please do not drop off your child if you have not made arrangements in advance.** It will be your responsibility to fill in earned vacation days ahead of a planned absence. If you do not have earned vacation days, you will be charged for a scheduled day even if your child is sick on that day.

During the school year, we offer many educational extras such as instruction in Italian, and German languages; in addition to an Art Program and a challenging curriculum in language arts, math, and sciences.

Monthly Menu and Snack Policy

Each month we publish a new menu listing each days' snacks and lunches. Please make sure you are checking the menu regularly, especially if your child has any food allergies or sensitivities.

For example, if your child cannot drink milk, be aware that we often serve dairy items at snack — such as cheese, yogurt, cottage cheese, and ice cream. On days when the snack is something that your child cannot eat, **please provide** an alternate snack.

However, if the snack is something that your child doesn't enjoy eating, our policy is we will serve that item to your child in the hopes that he or she will be encouraged to try new things. Do not send in alternate snacks unless your child is actually allergic or sensitive to a certain food.
