Outdoor Play

Please ensure your child comes to school with appropriate outdoor clothing, including mittens, a hat, socks, boots, and a warm winter coat. If your child wears boots to school, please remember to send indoor shoes as well.

For safety and comfort, children must have **all required winter items** to participate in outdoor play.

If you would like your child's winter items to remain at the center, please let staff know. All winter gear should be clearly labeled with your child's name. Additionally, please check your child's belongings daily to ensure items are dry after outdoor play.

Snow Day Information

Please check **local news stations** for snow day and weather-related closure information.

It is not typically the policy of Great Lakes Child Development Center to close due to sub-freezing temperatures alone. The center will close only if road conditions are deemed unsafe for driving due to heavy snowfall or icy conditions.

Please monitor local **TV and radio news stations** for school closings. We will be listed as **GLCDC–Warren**.

As of January 5, the office will begin accepting requests for 2025 year-end statements. Please fill out the yellow pad located in the vestibule to request your year-end tax

HEARING & VISION SCREENING

Hearing and vision screenings will be conducted on **Thursday, March 12, at 8:30 AM**, for all children who are **3 years of age or older on that date**. More details will be shared closer to the date.

Please note that children who will be attending **Kindergarten next year are required to have this screening completed** for registration purposes.

If your child does not attend GLCDC on this day, they are still welcome to come in for the screening. Parents may remain on site while testing is completed.

If your child misses the scheduled screening, families will be responsible for completing the hearing and vision screening independently for Kindergarten registration.
